Her research is mainly focused in the field of disposable colorimetric sensors for different food degradation monitoring with particular attention to the development and optimization of such devices for in field and large-scale application using several chemometric tools. On this topic, Lisa Rita Magnaghi attended the School of Experimental Design and the School of Multivariate Data Analysis in Genova in 2019.

Lisa Rita Magnaghi is one of the founder members of the start-up SAFER SmartLabels s.r.l., founded on July 15th, 2020 together with Prof. Raffaella Biesuz and Prof. Paolo Quadrelli.

The scientific activity of Lisa Rita Magnaghi is documented so far by more than 10 papers published on international journals, 4 patents deposited and participation to national and international meetings.
